



## **BOIL WATER NOTICE RESCINDED**

**City of Winnsboro, Texas | PWS ID: TX250000 4**

**Date of Rescission: January 30, 2026**

On January 28, 2026, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) required the City of Winnsboro public water system to issue a Boil Water Notice to inform customers, individuals, or employees that due to conditions which occurred recently in the public water system, the water from this public water system was required to be boiled prior to use for drinking water or human consumption purposes.

The public water system has taken the necessary corrective actions to restore the quality of the water distributed by this public water system used for drinking water or human consumption purposes and has provided TCEQ with relevant laboratory test results that indicate that the water no longer requires boiling prior to use as of January 30, 2026 @ 3:30 pm.

### **ACTIONS RECOMMENDED**

**You may now resume normal water usage .**

It is recommended that you:

- **Flush Pipes:** Run all cold-water faucets for 1-3 minutes.
- **Ice Makers:** Discard any ice made during the notice and run 2-3 batches of new ice before use.
- **Water Softeners/Filters:** Follow manufacturer instructions for flushing or replacing filters.
